SCHOOL CANTEEN

We have exciting news regarding the ordering of student lunches. We have been able to liaise with Danny Dedes, principal of Taylors Lakes Secondary College to organize lunch orders from their canteen provider, Queen Baker Catering. We will be commencing lunch orders to start next Wednesday 16 November. We are waiting for a modified menu to be provided for our students. We should have this by Monday, and we will send it out via SENTRAL and hard copies given to the students. Children will need to order their selected lunch on a brown paper bag. They must have their name, year level and class e.g. 1/2B, what they are ordering and the amount. Lunch orders will arrive at Monmia between 1:15-1:30pm. School. We will be providing further information as soon as we have it. This service will cease operating on Tuesday 13 December.

YEAR 3-6 CAMP

The countdown has begun for the Year 3-6 Camp which will be held from Monday 5 December to Wednesday 7 December. We were very fortunate to find a camp, and this was due to Merryn Auld's persistence in finding an appropriate placement. School Council had provided their approval for this camp and the approximate costs. The final figures for the camp costs are higher than we expected due to increases in petrol and bus costs as well as meals. Please remember that you are able to pay this in instalments.

SCHOOL ORGANISATION

We are returning to our usual processes of grade allocation for 2023. Besides the "in depth" contribution of the class teachers, children also have input in **nominating 'Learning Buddies' who are students with whom they work well and are not necessarily their social friends**. Students are guided through this process, as it is our core purpose to give every child the opportunity to develop to their full potential.

At Monmia, we are fortunate to have such wonderful teachers, who work exceptionally hard in collaborative teams to ensure all children receive the same high standard educational opportunities. As teachers are not allocated to grades until all students have been placed, it is school policy that requests for specific teachers will not be accommodated. It is essential that if there are requests related to student's educational needs parents/guardians notify the school in writing and due consideration will be given to these.

Once the classes are finalised we are unable to make any further changes. Even if parents/guardians have made specific requests in previous years, we ask that a new written request be made for 2023. If the request is not in writing and addressed to Lorraine, the Principal, it will not be taken into consideration. All written requests must be handed into the office by FRIDAY 11 NOVEMBER.

Parents/Guardians, you have entrusted the school to make the best decisions about their child and their learning all year. Please trust that we will place your child with his/her best interests considered.

As we are trying to finalise staffing for next year, it is vital that we have accurate details of enrolments. If you are transferring out of the area at the end of the year or know of new families enrolling at Monmia next year it is very important that you let the office know as soon as possible by completing the slip in this newsletter.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

It is important to know what bullying is and what it is not. The Department of Education and Training's definition is:

'Bullying is when someone, or a group of people, deliberately upset or hurt another person or damage their property, reputation or social acceptance on more than one occasion. There is an imbalance of power in incidents of bullying with the bully or bullies having more power at the time due to age, size, status or other reasons'.

Bullying can take many forms:

- 1. Direct physical bullying
- 2. Direct verbal bullying
- 3. Indirect emotional bullying
- 4. Cyber-bullying







- As well as receive real-time notifications and messages from the school or your child's classroom teacher.


How to Access:
